- 4. Three letters of recommendation: It is best to have these done by a professor or an overseer at your work. They may be sent under separate cover or by email.
- 5. A statement of past experiences and professional goals: Although the format will vary from individual to individual, these personal statements should include summaries of previous professional and educational experiences that were of a concentrated nature similar to the SVI as well as a description of how the SVI will facilitate attainment of future goals.

Applications received after March 1 will be reviewed on a space-available basis. The registration packet may be emailed, faxed, or mailed.
